Veteran Employment Advisory Committee Meeting – 2 April 2025

The inaugural meeting of the Veteran Employment Advisory Committee (VEAC) occurred on Wednesday 2 April 2025. The VEAC was formed following a refresh of the previous Industry Advisory Committee on Veterans' Employment (IAC).

The VEAC provides strategic advice to Government (through the Department of Veterans' Affairs, and Department of Defence) from a diverse industry perspective to operationalise the *Working Future: The Australian Government's White Paper on Jobs and Opportunities* policy focus areas relevant to veteran and partner employment.

At the first VEAC meeting, the Committee identified key priorities that may be used to inform future agendas and to potentially be raised with the Minister as to the proposed direction of the Committee. The Committee also successfully endorsed their Terms of Reference and confirmed the appointment of the VEAC Deputy Chair Adam Frizell, General Manager AeroPM, through a vote.

After discussion, the Chair noted the positive ideas and contributions and the need to focus on these in the work of the Committee.
